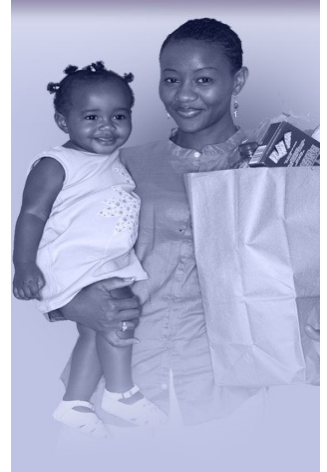

These are items that our clients most often need



Most Needed:

- Deodorant, Hand/Body lotion, Razors, Body wash, Q-tips, Hairbrushes
- Baby Shampoo, Baby Lotion & Baby wipes
- Twin &/or Double Comforters/Quilts, Wash-clothes
- New socks & Underwear (women & children-all sizes)
- New Pajamas, Robes, Slippers (women & children-all sizes)
- New Casual Wear, such as sweat shirt/pants (women & children-all sizes)
- Nail clippers, Nail Polish Remover, Nail Files, Tweezers
- Shampoo & Conditioner (Regular/Full Size)
- Toothbrushes & Toothpaste, Mouthwash, Floss

- Toilet Paper
- Paper Towels
